



University of Biskra Contribution to No poverty efforts

Following Law No. 98-11 of August 22, 1998 on the orientation and program law with a five-year projection on scientific research and technological development, following Law No. 99-05 of April 4, 1999 on the law of orientation on higher education, following Executive Decree No. 219-98 of July 8, 1998 establishing the University of Biskra, following Executive Decree No. 90-09 dated February 17, 2009 and Executive Decree No. 129-14 of April 5, 2014,

- the University of Biskra contributes to and encourages programs aimed at eliminating poverty among different categories of students such as those in need, and those, like all Algerian university establishments, by granting to all students:

1. A monthly grant (self-employed students),
2. Free education,
3. Free access: to courses, access to training workshops, access to practical work, access to educational laboratories, access to research laboratories, access to university libraries, access to internships and sports halls and the cultural activities rooms of the university,
4. The offer of prepared meals in university refectories (for all students, against a very reduced price),
5. The subsidy of urban and semi-urban transport (for all students, against a very reduced price),
6. The university residence subsidy (for all students, for a very reduced price),
7. The free provision of health services (consultation, general care, dental care, etc.)

- Furthermore, the University of Biskra participates in the policy of combating poverty through the organization and participation in scientific and cultural events, at the local, regional, national and/or international level.
